Conclusions. Very likely that the husband of Ann of Cockermouth was John Swindlehurst, brother of Sarah Jane, with their parents being William born <1821> (Canada?) and wife Ann of Preston. William had a possible brother Robert born <1820> (Canada?),

and a possible second brother Edward (of Silver Street) born Preston <1828-31>. If all this true, then the parents of these 3 brothers seem to

have returned to England between 1821-1828/31 [Check ship passenger lists, Canadian records/websites etc].

From a Kendal website: In the mid 19th century the demand for gunpowder led to the Stricklands from Sizergh and the Wakefields from Sedgwick supporting the development of a gunpowder mill using the water power which was readily available - 'but don't scare my salmon', said one. By 1880 Mr Swinglehurst, who lived at Hincaster House, had control of the gunpowder works, and became a local squire figure. His house had been gentrified earlier in the century by 'cladding' the rough walls with dressed limestone. Mr Swinglehurst built a small mission room onto one of the cottages on the green where Sunday school was held until the 1940s. Even in the 1920s these gunpowder works drew labour from the village. Later the works were moved to a bigger site at Gatebeck, and later still ICI took them all over. Only worn down mill race walls remain.

George Swindlehurst who died April 30th 1897 aged 81 years, also Ann his beloved wife who died December 27 1908, aged 82 year [born abt 1826], also if John their son who died November 27th 1895 aged 37 years also of Ann their daughter who died December 21st 1916 aged 65 years, also of Esther Sarah Norris, daughter of the above who died September 18th 1922, aged 73 years, also of Mary Swindlehurst, daughter of the above who died January 4th 1923 aged 71 years. Also of James Swindlehurst who died November 23rd 1949 aged 83 years.

So these look like the ones that appear in the censuses, but is this Ann called Baxendale?

Turning to Ann Baxendale of Farington, I had a look at the entry for Leyland

George married Ann who hailed from Farrington sometime around 1848.

Mary Alice was baptised in St. John's church Preston on the 24th May 1863 and on the 1871 census she appears as a 7 year old Scholar at 18 River Street and born in Preston. This indicates that the family came to Preston from Barton between 1859 and 1863.

In 1881 she was a 17-year-old Cotton Weaver living at 18 River Street.

While searching the 1922 Electoral Register for Park Ward, Preston for Lillian Swindlehurst (the daughter of Elizabeth Ellen Swindlehurst) when she would have reached 21 years of age, I came across Mary Alice. Mary Alice lived with her husband John William Simmons at 24 St. Christopher's Road, just off St. George's Road, Preston. [Mary & John William Simmonds married 1905 Preston]

Ron: I have attached a strip (to keep the size down) from the marriage certificate of William Swindlehurst and Elizabeth Weavall. I wonder what you make of the second witness? My best guess is Lucy Hamfrath!!

With update from Ron: my new best guess is Mary Thompson. One of the servants in the 1851 census for Bleasdale Tower was Mary Thomson aged 21 born in Bentham Westmorland. Reference previous from Ron:

From a copy of the marriage certificate of William Swindlehurst and Elizabeth Weavell, in Aug 8 1849 her father was given as Samual and she was given as 21 years of age. The marriage was witness by Robert Swindlehurst (who is he father, brother?) and ? as yet unreadable.

This would give her dob as 1828. Later censuses say she was born in Sandon staffs.

The nearest I have for her is 30 Dec 1827 Elizabeth dau of Samual and Sarah WEAVER of Sandon labourer.

I did wonder what brought a girl from Staffordshire to Bleasdale Tower. The 1851 census shows William Garnett barrister and JP there. At the Lodge were Hannah Mather aged 63 Lodge keeper Of Oldham and her children Mary mather 25 Launderess born hanbury staffs and John Mather aged 23 labourer of Hanbury.

If you trace these via the IGI you can find the children were baptised in Marchington staffs which is about 8 miles from Sandon

So the theory goes that Mr Garnett asked the lodge keeper if he new any good servants and he recommended Elizabeth Weavell! How about that for a flight of fancy. I was hoping to show that Hannah was a Weaver too but as she was born in Oldham it rather spoils it. I can't ascertain her maiden name.

My wife's g g grandfather, William Swindlehurst was baptised at St. Eadmer's church in Bleasdale on the 30th May 1813.²

His whereabouts in 1841 have not been discovered. He was not with the rest of the family at Nateby.

William was married to Elizabeth Weavell at St. Eadmer's church (Admarsh Chapel) on August 8th 1849. He was a farmer at Sandham Mill and she was a Houseservant at Bleasdale Tower. She was 21 years old and born in Sandon, Staffordshire. Her father was called Samual, a servant.

The 1851 census sees William safely ensconced at Sandham Mill, Barnacre with his wife and baby son William.

By 1861 he has moved with his family to Hill Top farm, Barton and farmed 39 acres. Three more children were born here, Sarah Ann (my wife's g grandmother), James and Catherine.⁴

In 1871 the family lived at 18 River Street, Preston where he was a 51-year-old Dairyman. They have one more child here, Mary A aged 7.5

The author of 'Dashes at Iniquity' was John Anderson, born around 1820, so the piece is definitely well out of copyright, and you will be free to reproduce it. We have a little bit about him in the multi-volume 19th century anthology Modern Scottish Poets.

Mr. Anderson wrote much in prose and verse, and published a series of political sketches in verse, entitled 'Dashes at Iniquity, by Luke, the Labourer'.

"Luke the Labourer" is the title of a play by John Baldwin Buckstone, an English playwright. It does seem to me slightly more likely that a Scottish poet might send something protesting about a Scottish landowner to a Scottish newspaper, with (now that you have sent me the text of it), quite a bit of knowledge about the setting of the Duke's new palace at

Hamilton, and some distinctly Scottish sentiment in the last verse? Maybe he used the nom-de-plume of 'Luke the Labourer' because the play was so well-known?

This poem was written some time in the 1850s, and was printed in the Glasgow Sentinel, whence it has been copied.

BENEVOLENCE. His Grace the Duke of Hamilton has just caused to be distributed the usual donation, from the palace, of butcher-meat and oat-meal, to upwards of 500 individuals and heads of families in the town of Hamilton - Glasgow paper.

God pity the poor! and preserve the good Duke, Who sent back the crumbs from the loaves which he took From hedgers and ditchers, those ignorant clods, Whose spoil gilds the walls of his royal abodes. Our great Exhibition will show to the earth The genius of labor as well as its worth; But nothing will stand in that emporium grand, That rank can say came from its profligate hand.

God pity the poor! who, like skeletons, pine By the side of hid Grace, full of dainties and wine, All drawn from the toilers upon his estate - You may reckon him mean, but certainly not blate. Every floweret, they say, has its own drop of dew, Of station this precept has never been true: Every pulse of its heart is sustained in its glow by sweat from the laborer's sorrowful brow.

God pity the poor! let the poor thank the Peer, Whose oat-meal advertisement reads rather queer; The poor folk are feasted on what is their own, And the Duke claims the praise for the charity done. Admiration in bushels may fall on his head, When he gives the down-trodden a holiday fees; How few take the trouble an hour to inquire Why workmen want dinner, or clothing, or fire!

Industrious poor! What a puzzle to me
To make those two jarring fag-ends well agree!
Industrious poor! If they waste what they gain,
They are not industrious, my doctrine is plain.
Industrious poor! But they really are poor Then some Swindlehurst brought the curse to the door;
The provident man, if no knave interfere,
Will never want freedom, nor comfort, nor cheer.

Benevolence! small is the Bedlamite's sense, Who wants us to swallow that stark insolence; Benevolence! stealing your log, if we must, And giving the owner the precious saw-dust! Benevolence! nothing on earth can surpass This Hamilton kindness for baseness and brass; The weakest must it feel it a glaring misdeed To pilfer their acres, and pay them with bread!

Benevolence! Well, it is much, to be sure, To see his Grace drawing so close to the poor; What a lesson for thousands in times that are by, Had Dukes kept their fingers more out of the pie! Position is something, like Joseph's one sheaf, All else must bend down to the dust in their grief; Swallow up! swallow up! it proclaims night and day, Swallow up! swallow every thing comes in the way! The patches of ground that for ages have stood, To do the poor peasants a world of good, By the rim of the river, a few paces square, With modern improvements, no longer are there. Every acre Mr Adam has left to bear fruit Belongs to the palace, or abbey, no doubt; And millions that Heaven ordained for the soil, Have not an inch left for existence the while!

Down, down with the rabble - yes, farther down still - Drive, drive them from woodland, and valley, and hill; Shut, shut them all out from the summer and spring, They must not smell flowers, nor hear warblers sing. The sunshine is sweet, and the blossoms are fair, But rank must possess these delights every where; Give poor people cellars, where light will not come, To showm them the horrors that tenant their home!

Not cart-loads of meal, no, nor thousands of loaves, Shall bribe me to puff up a custom I loathe; If the gift has been pilfered, I'll spit on the boon, And call the vile donor a villainous loon! Give back our inheritance - give us our land - And elbow-room fir for the bee-hive to stand; The Labor will rise on its pinions of power, And wither'd stems bloom like a jessamine flower.

Petitions for bread let us strongly despise, A mendicant's wail is not Scottish nor wise; Let us seek independence in trouble and strife -That peril of manhood - that jewel of life. As a mate for our Thistle - our Thistle so grand -This virtue must bloom in our dear father-land; Till every lone nook shall partake of its cheer, And pauper relief, like a curse, disappear.
