From the website Our Families Roots found by David:

In 1868 a gentleman by the name of Daniel D. McArthur departed from St George, Utah, leading a group of out-and-back teamsters to Benton, Wyoming. They left Salt Lake in mid-June, travelling east by way of Parley's Canyon, where they encountered a blinding spring blizzard. It also took them a full day to swim their herd of oxen across the Green River, which was swollen from the spring runoff. They reached the end-of-track terminus of Benton in July and waited about six weeks for a group of emigrants, most of whom had crossed the Atlantic on the steamship Colorado. It took the emigrants about a week to travel on the train from New York to the outfitting place. The emigrants arrived in Benton, where they met their teamsters on August 7 and left a week later. The company included 411 passengers and 61 wagons. Twenty-five of the wagons were loaded with goods destined for stores in Salt Lake, including the new Zion's Cooperative Mercantile Institution. They travelled in a north-westerly direction from Benton through Whiskey Gap and northward from there until they reached the Sweetwater River and joined the old emigrant road. They arrived in Salt Lake on September 2. Seven people, mostly young children, died en route.

Included in the party of emigrants were John (55) and Matilda Rothwell (38) Swindlehurst (presumably the parents) and Isabel Hannah (15), Sophia (13), Charlotte (11), Amelia (8), Edwin (4) and Thomas Wilford Swindlehurst (1).

Note 1: the record does not say if the seven who died included 1 or more of the Swindlehurst family.

Note 2: a Charlotte Swindlehurst married, on 26th April 1878, John Andrew Smith in St George, Utah.

Note 3: At that time Benton Wyoming was the railhead of the Union Pacific railway. Subsequently the line was extended westward and Benton died and disappeared from history, as Rawlins became the rail centre. (See Wyoming Place Names by Mae Urbanek). This info courtesy of Curtis Greubel, Archives and Graphics Supervisor, Wyoming State Archives.

Dy: John (b 1812) married Margaret Hopwood. They had 7 children. Margaret and 6 of the 7 children died between 1840 and 1851.

Margaret died in Sept 1851 and John married Matilda Rothwell in Jan 1852!! They had 8 children and it was this family that emigrated to Utah

as John became an LDS member along with the rest of his family. It was John who wrote a record of his family for the LDS. John and Matilda

went to the USA on the ship Antarctic in May 1863 with Isabella, Sophia, Charlotte, Amelia and William in May 1863. They return to the UK before

the burial of William in July 1863. They stayed in the UK until embarking on the ship Colorado in July 1868 taking the children listed above plus

Edwin and Thomas Wilford

Dy: Having confirmed that Richard's father was indeed Thomas Sw., I have tracked the family down in the 1871, 1861 and 1881 census. Have attached copies of all census to this email for you.

The family lived in what was then a village called Scorton not far from Lancaster. Scorton is now a district of Lancaster having been absorbed when the city expanded. Lancaster, which is a city, is in Lancashire - shire simply meaning county.

In 1861 their exact address is not given. It just states Scorton Village.

In 1871 they are living in St Anne's Place, Scorton.

In 1881they are in North Edward Street, Scorton which you will remember was the address Richard gave for his residence on the marriage certificate. [Pedder 1873/Butler 1852]

All this helps to confirm that we have the right family here.

Thomas Swindlehurst's birth is usually stated as Scorton but in the 1871 census it says Wyersdale. The correct spelling of this should be Wyresdale and is pronounced 'Wires-dale.' Wyresdale is the descriptive name for an area in central Lancashire. It includes the beautiful Forest of Bowland and is centred on the source of the River Wyre. Wyresdale is also often split into two areas - Over Wyresdale and Nether Wyresdale. Scorton is in Nether Wyresdale.

Taking the evidence of the census and working on the birth of Richard there is only one birth that fits.

Richard Swindlehurst born Preston April/May/June quarter of 1853 - ref 8e 395.

Obtaining this certificate should be your next step to definitely proving Richard's parents.

I expect the birth cert to prove that Richard's parents were Thomas Swindleurst and his wife Nancy nee Butler.

There is a marriage for Thomas Swindlehurst to Nancy Butler in the April/May/June quarter of 1852 in Garstang - ref 8e 693. That cert would give you the names of the respective fathers to Thomas and Nancy.

I couldn't find Thomas or Nancy in the 1891 census. I have found two death refs which look as if it could be them. Given the closeness of the date perhaps there was some kind of epedemic in Lancaster at the time.

Ch: Edward Swinglehurst (former wife Rachel) married Sarah Clifton1869. Edward born abt 1828, died Jan 13, 1873 Alexandria, Egypt. His Will of 1869 refers to the children of his first wife Rachel: Henry, Edward, Augusta Ann Alexandra Swinglehurst who were living with their guardian Henry at Hincaster House. Also mentioned are his mother Lydia, his sister Barbara Airey and his brother James

Dy: I notice also that you have Edward Swinglehurst as married twice - 1st wife Rachel ?? 2nd wife Sarah Clifton. The mention of the children of his first marriage in the will of 1869 is interesting. There is a marriage of an Edward Swinglehurst in Preston in the Jan quarter 1852. Appearing on the same page in the GRO indexes is Rachel Statters. A fairly safe assumption that she was the missing one. There is a Rachel Statters in the 1851 census for Preston living with her brothers and sisters. She is a power loom weaver and was born in Lancaster c1829. In the 1841 census she is in Lancaster with her parents George and Ann Statters. The siblings match the 1851 census so I am sure it is her. From what you have said I do not think Chris knows about the Swinglehurst/Jelph marriage entry in Gloucestershire.

Robert Swindlehurst was baptised at St. Eadmer's church in Bleasdale on the 8th December 1822.22

His parents were given as William and Nancy Swinglehurst a Farmer of Barnacre.

In 1841 he was 16 years old and living on the farm with his parents at Nateby.²³

In 1851, now aged 28 years, he was still living with his parents on the farm at Nateby.²⁴

By 1861 Robert was a 38-year-old gamekeeper living in Garstang with his 37-year-old wife Margaret.²⁵

In 1871 Robert appears to have changed his career. He was now the Innkeeper of the Pack Horse Inn, Garstang and a farmer of 16 acres employing 1 man. His wife Margaret was 49 and born in Barnacre. His children were listed as Alice aged 9, George aged 8, John William aged 5 and brother James aged 40. Jane Bentham a possible daughter of Robert's older sister Ann was a 27-year-old general servant.²⁶

By 1881, Robert was a farmer of 18 acres at Garstang and a 57-year-old widower. His children were Alice aged 19, George, 18, an apprentice Blacksmith, and John William, 15, a farmer's son.²⁷

Jane Bentham was still here, unmarried and 38 years of age. She is now described as a niece of Robert. His brother James aged 50 also lived here as a Farm labourer. 27

From Freebmd there is a Robert Swindlehurst who died in Garstang aged 83 in the March quarter of 1906, 8e, 497.

The story of the family from Mary Swinglehurst. (My Father's sister)

My Grandfather was called John Swinglehurst, and his wife was Harriet Nield. I don't know the date of their marriage but it must have been in the late 1850's.

They had 9 children – six boys and three girls. John, the eldest, was 21 by the time the youngest, my Father was born in 1880, so John must have been born in 1859. John was 'something in the city', regarded by the younger members of the family with awe. He used to sing in the Philharmonic Choir and always sounded rather pompous to me.

Lizzie came next, the eldest of the girls; home loving and very nice. She married Harry Tranter and had two children – Harry and May. (Sorry – no dates.)

Two boys came next – Charles & Frank. They both married and had children, but I'm afraid I don't know their names or anything about them.

Both Charles and Frank went into decorating. Charles joined a firm of plumbers and decorators and became a sign-writer. He must have been rather artistic as my father remembers him testing his art on the back of the sitting room door! One month, a swan sailing placidly across a pond, another month, a country scene, another month a bouquet of

flowers. He worked hard and rose up in the firm to become a director by the time he retired. Charles also worked very hard for the Manchester and Salford Hospital Saturday Fund, and eventually a Convalescence Home was opened at Deganwy, in Wales that was named after him. (We have a mug to commemorate the opening)

Frank, on the other hand remained a painter and decorator with his own business. He did well, but not as well as Charles.

Two girls came next, Sal and Annie. They married and had children – again I don't know names or dates, but one of Sal's daughters bred Afghan Hounds or Salukis or some such. I remember being taken to see them one day, and being very impressed.

I don't know the name of the next boy, perhaps he died young?

However, next came Fred, who married Rhoda, who came originally from South Africa, where her parents lived. I remember them having some odd things in their house, including an elephant's foot as an umbrella stand and a fender made from the ivory from elephants tusks!! Fred was the nicest of the brothers to us, and the one we always stayed with when we went to Northenden. They had one son, William, who was older than us. Fred had a cycle shop with a sort of repair garage at the side. He was two years older than Harry, my father.

Harry, the youngest of the family and wanted to be an engineer, all his brothers advised against it. He persisted and managed to get his training, but found getting a job very difficult. He moved to Vickers in Barrow, where he got a job that suited him. However, he had a girl friend in Salford, Mary Ann Bond, a girl from a strict Catholic family, so he was in trouble again as the Swinglehurst's were all Protestants. In fact John (father) ran the Sunday School with a rod of iron in those days and allowed no 'tom-foolery' as he was fond of saying. Eventually, Mary Ann 'turned' for Harry and they went and buried her Prayer Book and Rosary Beads under a tree in Trafford Park in the days when it was parkland and not a sprawling industrial estate of today. They married at Stowell Memorial Church in Salford (now, only the spire remains as a landmark) on 26th December 1901 and moved into a house in Vickerstown on Walney Island, Barrow. They had Three Children, Harry, born in May 1903 but, sadly, died in 1904, Harold, born 30th January 1906 and Mary (me) born 8th March 1908.

My Father, Harry, was born on 6th March 1880 at 156 Robert Hall Street, Salford and the family later moved to 86 Phoebe Street, Salford. My mother Mary Ann was born on 27th June 1882 at Exeter Barracks where her father managed the canteen, after retiring from being a P. T. instructor in the army in India. Before coming to Barrow the family lived at 22 Enbridge Street, Salford.

Harry died on the 6th March 1962 (his birthday) and Mary Ann died five years later on 12th January 1967. They celebrated their Diamond Wedding on 25th December 1961.
